This program must be completed while residing in the state of California. Field Expedience and Clinical Practice Placements cannot be made outside of California. It is the responsibility of the candidate to notify the University of relocation outside of California.

To receive the Preliminary Administrative Services credential candidates are required to successfully complete all course work including field experiences, possess a valid prerequisite credential, verification of five years of teaching and/or services experience, 3.0 GPA, Zero account balance and completion of Cal APA Cycles 1, 2 and 3.
